Cairns Office Update

Projex North Engineering & PRP Town Planning are now settled into 228 Draper Street, located a kilometre from the Cairns CBD.

Currently the office is providing expert witness advice for a number of projects, including successfully supporting a rural subdivision application in the Planning and Environment Court. Work for other clients includes a major quarry expansion, two school as well as rural and residential subdivisions across the Far North.

Paga Hill Development

The Paga Hill Development is a 13 hectare, six star hotel, residential and business precinct located on a small peninsula directly adjacent to the CBD.

Applications for bulk earthworks and re-zoning have recently been submitted to the National Capital District Commission which will allow construction to commence.

Waria Waria Oil Project, Port Moresby

Following an eventful trip through the Torres Strait to Papua New Guinea earlier in the year, Projex North have secured additional infrastructure work in the developing areas of the Western Province.

Much of the construction will be completed using local labour as part of the Sustainable Development Projects program with Papua New Guinea.

Possible further road work, drainage culverts and wharf facilities may be completed under local government funding.

Shoal Point Development

Projex North has been commissioned to undertake Master Planning and Stage 1 Operational Works for the Shoal Point Development located 20kms north of Mackay.

The development comprises five residential stages including earthworks, road and pavement design, intersection design, stormwater drainage, water quality devices (bio-retention basins and gross pollutant traps), sewerage reticulation, sewer pump stations and rising mains and water reticulation.
